(\* Section 88A of the Local Electoral Act 2001 provides that if a person is declared to be elected as a member of the council, and that person is also declared to be elected as a member of a community board, that person must be treated as having vacated office as a member of the community board. As John Bishop and Sue Milner were both elected as Councillors and as members of the Cambridge Community Subdivision, they automatically vacate their Cambridge Community Subdivision positions in favour of the next highest polling candidate, being Philip Coles. As the number of candidates is still less than the number of vacancies a by-election to fill the remaining vacancy will be advertised later in the year)
