Plan change 17 the proposed rezoning of northern cnr Hautapu Rd and Peake rd from Rural to residential.

The specific provisions of the plan change my submission relates to are (give details):

Extension of the Industrial zone north of Hautapu Rd.

My submission is

The plan change to rezone this area from rural to industrial is a direct contravention of the recent elite soils legislation that is in place to protect New Zealand elite soils for agriculture and food production.

The plan change overrides respect for Māori heritage sites which are on the site and the neighbouring sites. The area has always been valuable arable land for horticultural food production and the industry would remove that ability of the land to provide food for future generations.

The increase in traffic would affect neighbouring horse properties and the ambience of the area which allows mares to foal without stress and anxiety.

There would be noise, odour and water pollution associated with industrialisation affecting the area along with the Mangone stream which has huge cultural significance for Ngati Haua and Ngati Koroki Kahukura. The mana whenua of the land.

This area has for Māori and latterly for European settlers provided food and nourishment for not only locals but exports.

I seek that the council does not implement plan change 17, the rezoning from rural to industrial land.
