1. The Northern Precinct development does not need access/egress to Middle Road to operate successfully. This proposed amendment is ambiguous. The residential neighbours wish to maintain their present lifestyle without extra traffic on a rural road
2. Pedestrian access to Narrows and Middle Roads is not necessary for the functioning of the Northern Precinct business
3. Land in this area is subject to a high-water table and is serviced by a variety of ditches, some flowing to the river via adjacent properties. There needs to be a plan for retention of water to moderate flows for the increased surface water anticipated
4. The Southern Links project has been postponed indefinitely and planning north of the Northern Precinct should be a Waipa District Plan consideration

That:

Our submission endeavours to enable a balance between the Northern Precinct commercial development and the preservation of a rural residential lifestyle. The proposal by Rukuhia Properties has not been discussed previously and threatens to change the interface of our community. We request that our land and therefore, community, is kept as a separate entity from the commercial development. We suggest that this can be achieved by ensuring that the development is bound by the Northern Precinct's land boundaries with no access or egress of any type to Middle or Narrows Road. We suggest that Middle Road should continue to be defined as it is at the present time. The roads are much used for recreational pursuits by the extended communities including Lowe and Raynes Roads
