The ecology report (Northern Precinct Expansion Assessment of Ecological Effects Prepared for Titanium Park Ltd & Rukuhia Properties Ltd Prepared by

Tonkin & Taylor Ltd April 2022) has not adequately assessed adverse effects on all habitats lost or indirectly affected, and recommendations made in the report are not comprehensive and those recommendations that have been made have not been adequately addressed in the proposed plan provisions.

The proposed plan provisions do not adequately mitigate offset or compensate for the loss of all bat habitats, including foraging and commuting habitats. The proposed plan provisions also do not provide enough specificity to ensure that the cumulative effects of land use change don't adversely affect bat

habitats, including artificial lighting and commuting flyways.
