My submission is

A review of and retreat from the current low-intensity model is long overdue. The low-intensity model is a descendant of the quarter-acre section culture which wastes space and which depends on cheap petrol and high incidence of car ownership. We are losing valuable open space and farmland, whereas there is an increasing need for modern multi-storey housing close to CBD. Te Awamutu has expanded horizontally, leaving a margin between the CBD (which may contract) and the good quality modern housing neighbourhoods. There is a rising number of semi-retired residents who may not wish to drive everywhere and would elect to live within walking distance of the CBD.
