I would like the to see the final plan to be better suited to the rural character of the Waipa District which, as it stands, this proposed plan does not. I feel strongly that all residential buildings should be limited to two stories maximum per lot if both units were to be more than one level. And a resource consent is still needed to ensure traffic movement is managed well, that each unit has adequate sunlight, as well as any neighbouring houses, and that healthy living is protected by ensuring each unit has a northfacing outdoor living area.
